Update on the 2004 Computerized Class VI Exam

As you know, the Class VI Waterworks exam has been offered in a computerized format during 2004. To date, the exam has been offered 4 times and 88 operators have taken the exam. Here are some updates on the exam:

- ❖ We have over a 95% pass rate for this year!!
- ❖ Most operators that have taken the exam have used the training material and classes sponsored by the *Virginia Center for Very Small Waterworks*
- ❖ Comments received by operators who have taken the exam give very positive, including that they prefer the computerized exam over a paper and pencil format.
- ❖ **The exam will again be offered in a computerized format in 2005!**
